



## *Garden Route Explorer*



### Day 1

On arrival in Cape Town the group will be met by their tour guide and taken to their accommodation. After checking in and freshening up we depart for the famous Victoria & Alfred Waterfront. Explore the Mall with its many shops and restaurants before we meet for a welcome to South Africa dinner at one of the Restaurants.

### Day 2

This morning we head to the Harley Depot early and after completing the formalities collect our bikes and head for the Peninsula. Our journey takes us along the Atlantic Coastline, across the famous Chapman's Peak Drive, into the Cape Peninsula National Park and through the leafy suburb of Constantia. We return to the hotel in the late afternoon.

### Day 3

After an early breakfast we bid Cape Town farewell and head for the passes. Travelling through the beautiful scenery of the Cape Winelands we explore the winding roads and drive along the Route 62 to Roberston. Enjoy a wine tasting before dinner on a working wine farm.

### Day 4

Our journey takes us through the Swartberg Mountains and into what is known as the Little Karoo. The Route 62 offers beautiful scenery and the wonderful country towns offer many an opportunity for a short stop. We arrive in Oudtshoorn, the ostrich capitol of South Africa, in the afternoon and check into our guesthouse on an ostrich farm. There is time for a refreshing swim before dinner.

Overnight: Dinner, bed & breakfast

### Day 5

This morning we explore the area and perhaps visit the Cango Caves or learn more about the ostrich industry before crossing over the Outeniqua Mountains to George. We ride through Wilderness and Sedgefield passing a series of fresh water lakes and reach our accommodation after crossing the magnificent Knysna Lagoon. After checking in and freshening up we head for the Knysna Waterfront.

### Day 6

Today we explore the Garden Route and travel through Nature's Valley. The Tsitsikamma Nature Reserve and Storms River Mouth are also on the itinerary and for the brave there is an opportunity to Bungee Jump at the Bloukrans Bridge (216m). In the afternoon we visit the seaside resort town Plettenberg Bay and keep a look out for whales and dolphins. We return to our guesthouse to freshen up before enjoying sunset cruise on the Knysna Lagoon.

This morning there is time for some last minute shopping and a visit to the top of Table Mountain. This excursion is weather dependant and therefore for your own account. Your guide will take to the airport in the afternoon in time for your flight home.
